ACCESS

By train :

From Paris gare de Lyon, take RER A direction Poissy or Cergy, stop at Maisons-Laffitte.

From Paris Gare du Nord take RER B direction St Rémy les Chevreuses, change at Châtelet les Halles to take RER A direction Poissy ou Cergy

By plane :

From Orly airport : take the « Orlyval » train up to Antony. Go out at Antony to take RER B direction St Rémy les Chevreuses, change at Châtelet les Halles to take RER A direction Poissy ou Cergy

From Roissy Charles De Gaulle airport : take RER B direction Paris, change at Châtelet les Halles

Going out from Maisons-Laffitte station : walk down Avenue de Longueil, at the end of it (facing the "old town doors), turn right and walk down Rue de Paris until you see our residence on the left hand side of the street

By car from Paris :

On the ring road : direction La Défense/Cergy, take A14 direction POISSY/ROUEN/CERGY, get to A86 by following direction COLOMBES/CERGY, drive through COLOMBRES by taking exit 2b BEZONS

Drive through Bezons, Houilles, Sartrouville (follow direction POISSY)

At the exit of Sartrouville you will face Maisons-Laffitte castle, MY SUITE INN is on its left after the round about (direction « centre ville »)

DISCOVERIES :

• **Maisons-Laffitte, City of Horse**, with its famous racecourse, is a green city bordered by 3500 ha of national forest. Crossed by the Seine, this charming small coty offers numerous walks either in the parks or in the gardens, without forgetting its Castle.

Masterpiece of François Mansart, Louis XIV 's architect and creator of the Versailles Castle. The Museum of Horse gathers works of art, objects with historical interest which belong to the races heritage.

All year around, it is possible to practice different activities such as : walks or rides in the forest, in the parks or along the Seine borders, horse rides, volley-ball & hand-ball (sport center at a 5 mn walking distance), tennis (tennis club with 4 courts), golf in St Germain en Laye, Practice with 50 booths (including 15 covered) on the courserace de Maisons-Laffitte.

It is also possible to organise visits based on the theme of the Horses, upon request: guided visit of the horses training center, of a stable with commentaries of the best trainers, discovery of the racecourse
